By Car

Leave the M5 at Exeter on the A30 towards Cornwall. In approx 30 miles pass the exit to Launceston and take the next exit signed A395 North Cornwall. Continue along the A395 until it reaches the junction with the A39 where directions to Boscastle are clearly marked.

By Train Bodmin Parkway rail station is on the main Exeter/Plymouth/Penzance line and is approx 25 miles away. Please phone for Public transport timetable information.
